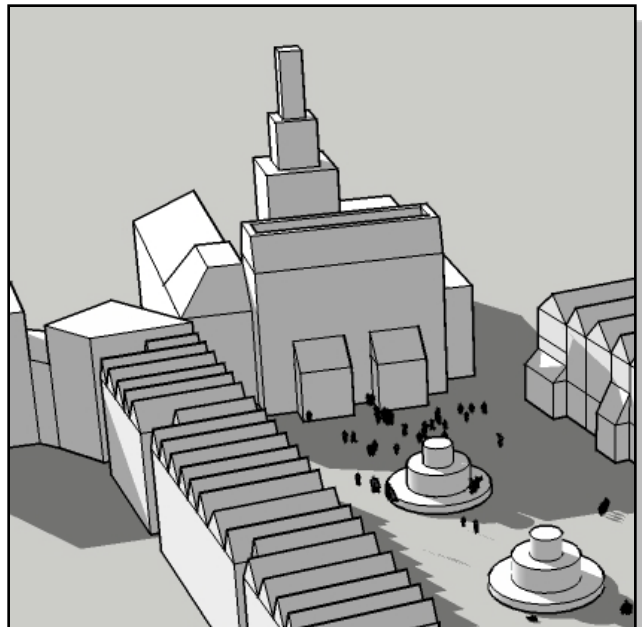
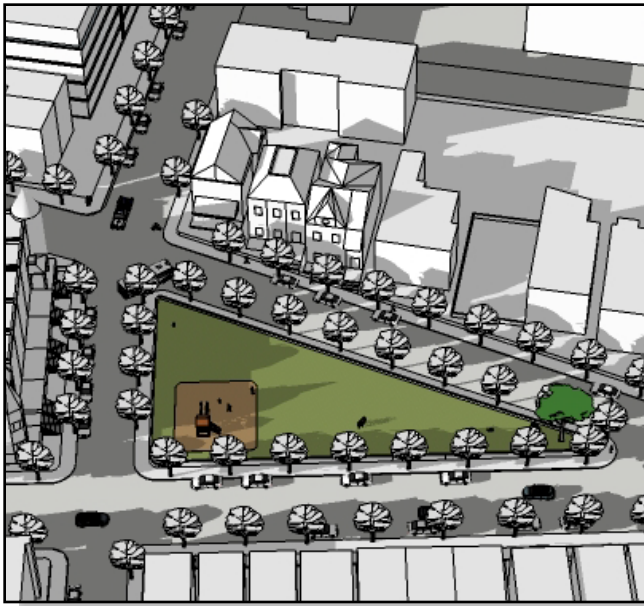

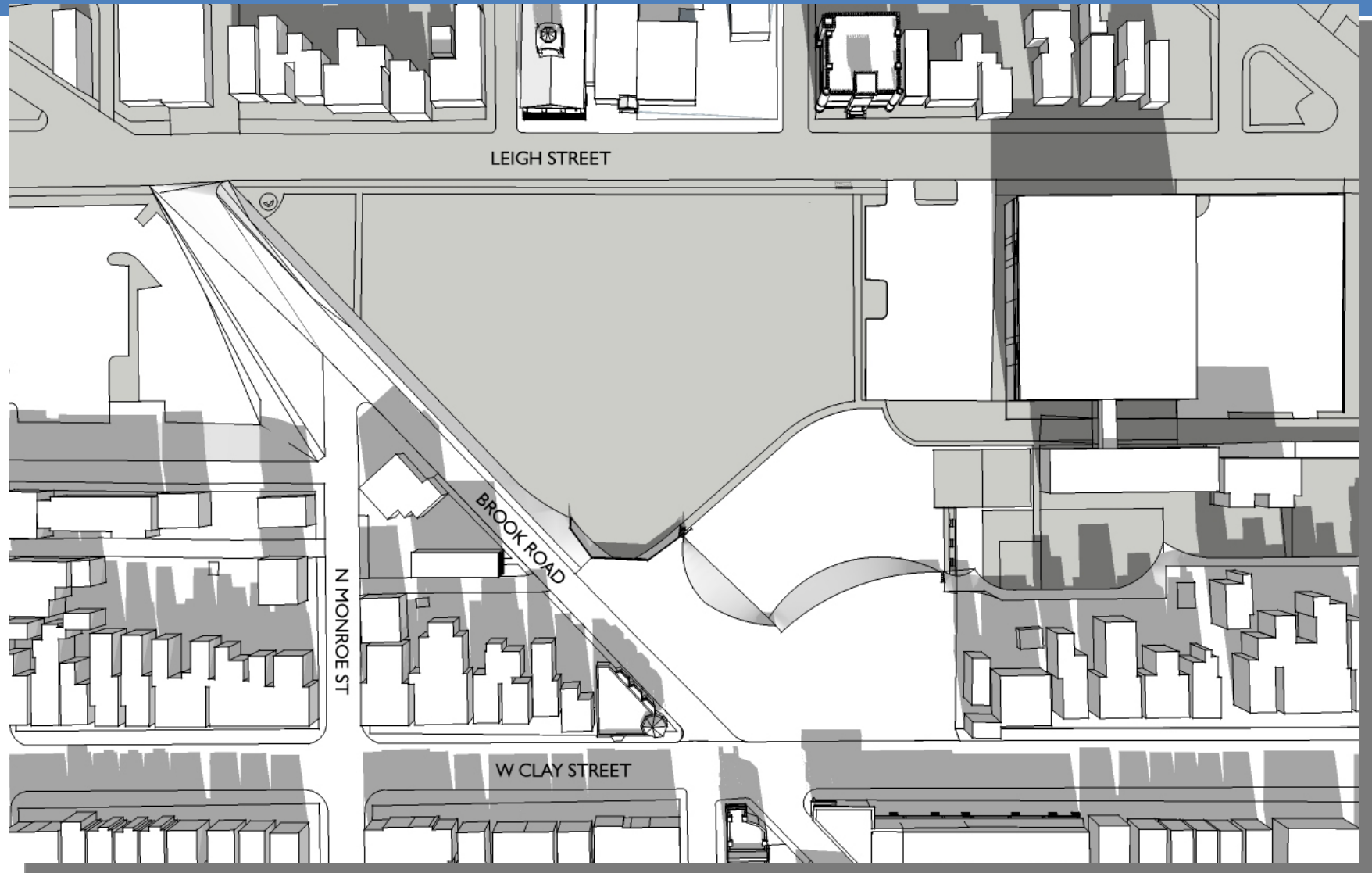


# Abner Clay Park – Prospective Park/Urban Design Schematic – Current Conditions

- Visibility

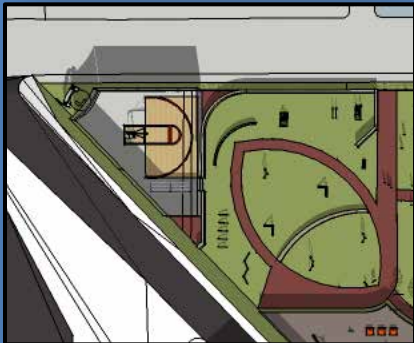




# Exercise Park\ Basketball Court

# Ruff Time – Dog Park

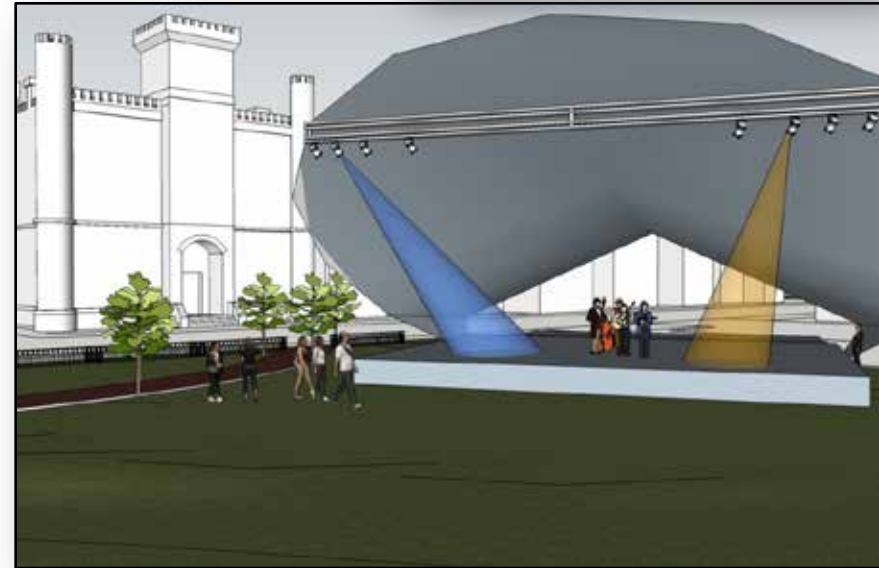
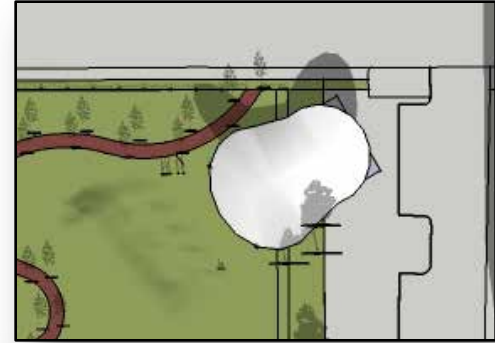
- Socialization of people and their animal companions

- Provides a safety factor for people enjoying the park area





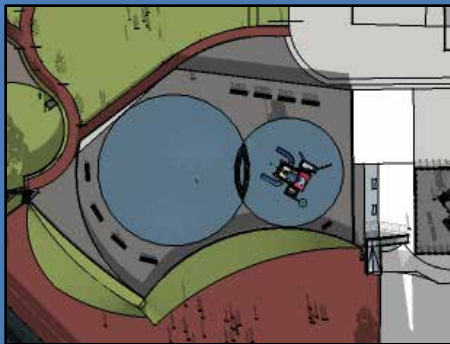
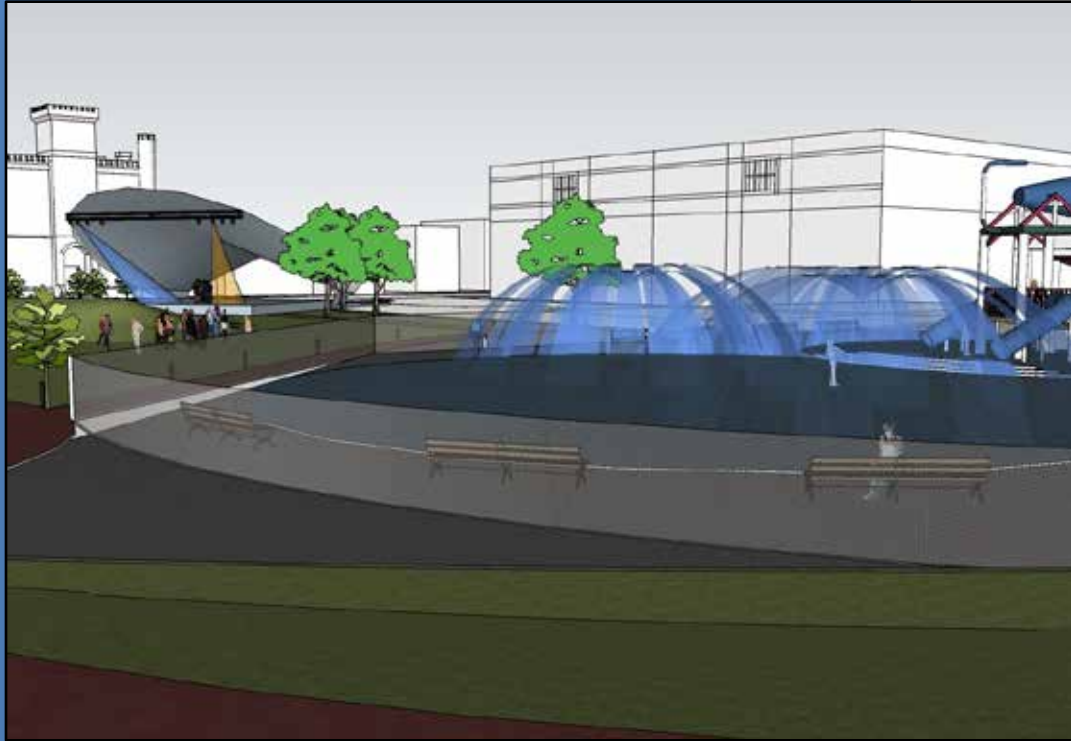
# Bandshell Pavilion – Arts & Entertainment Complex

- Slight raised area with seating facing pavilion/band stage area

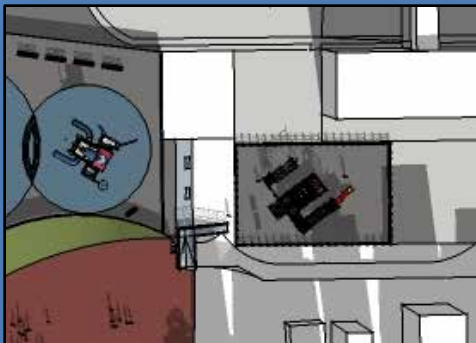
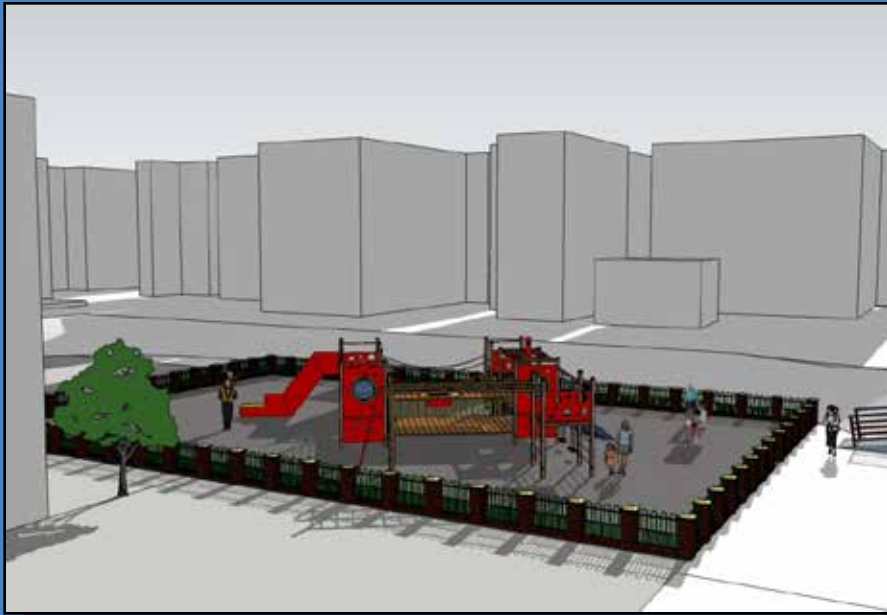
# "SPLASHDOWN" Splashpad & Children's' Playground

- Provides exercise for the kids in both warm and cool climates

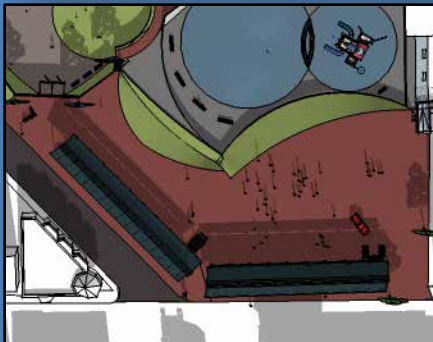

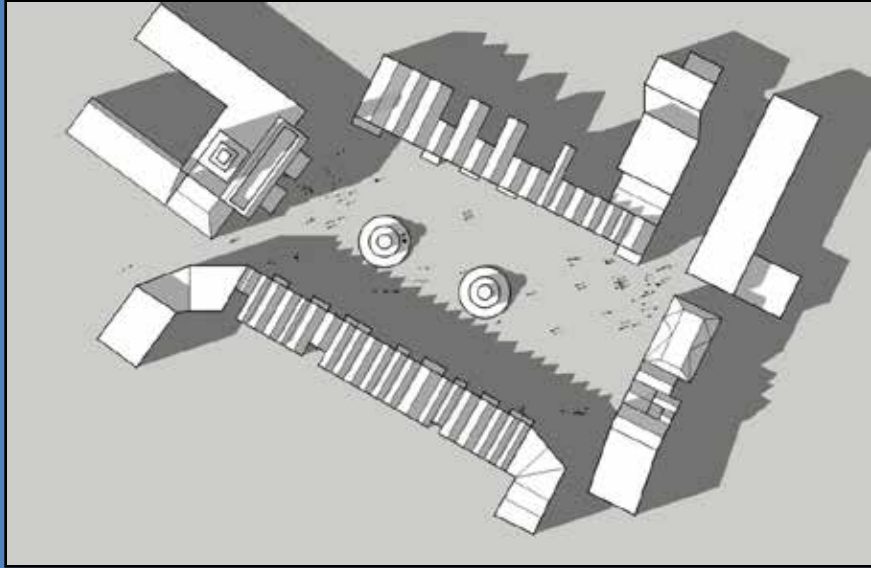
# Local Growers Farmers' Market

- Can be seen from Broad Street as a focal element to the park

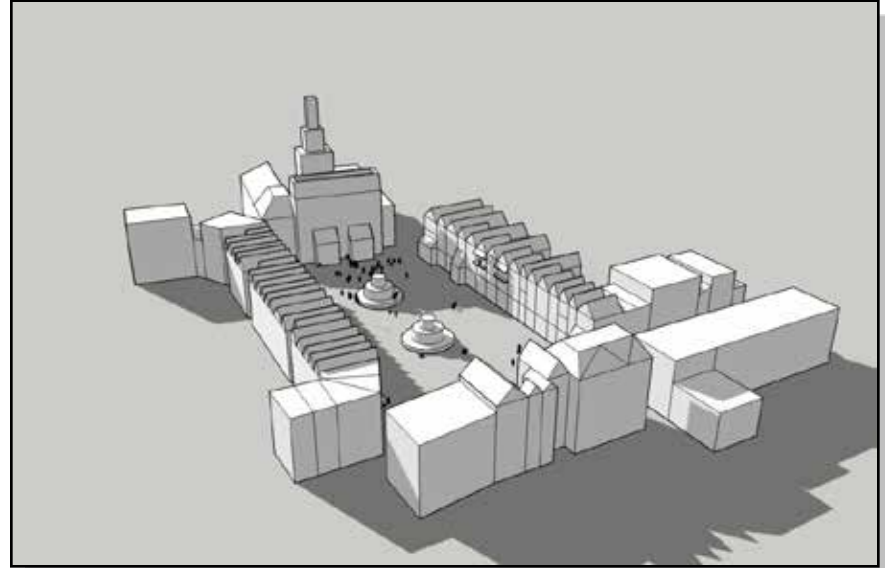

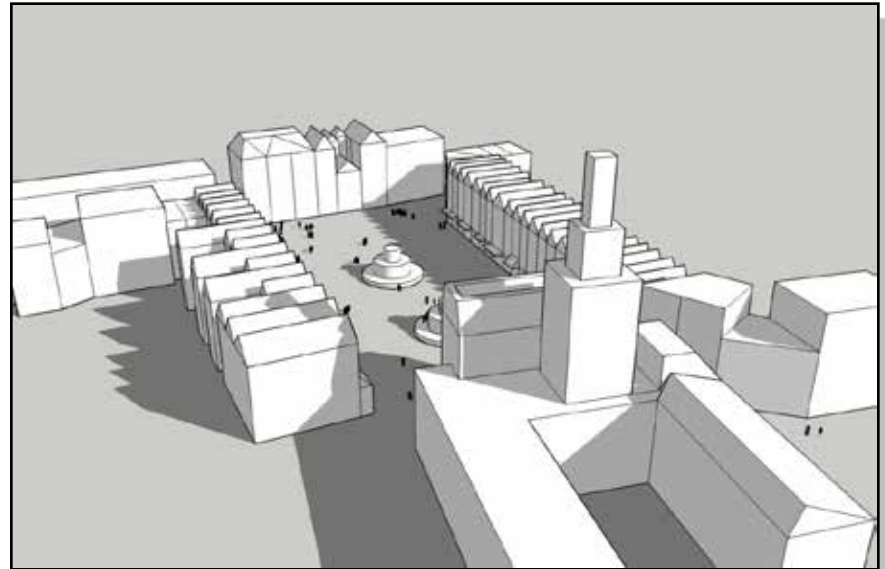
Plan View

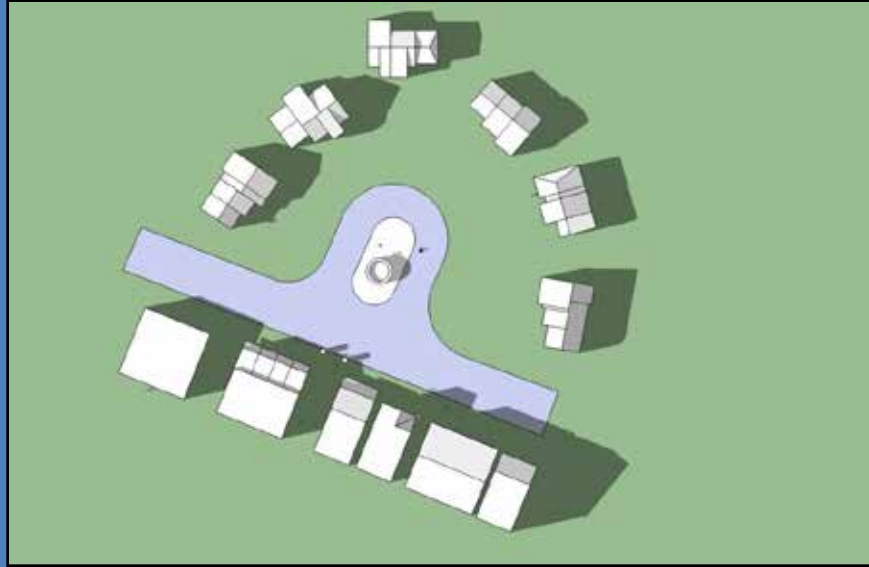


Ground Level Perspective

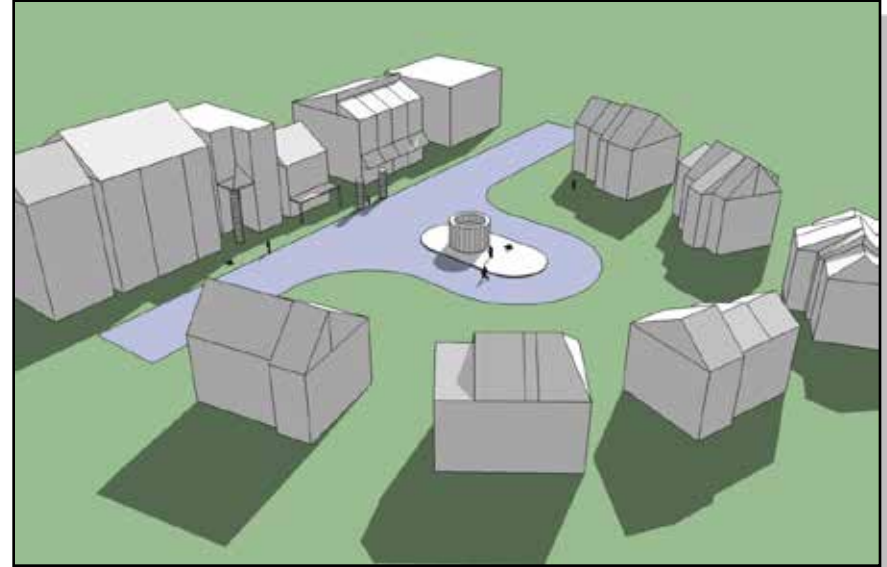
